





# Compression du plexus par un cal hypertrophique

## Fracture callus

The close proximity of the supraclavicular nerves to the clavicle renders them vulnerable to injury in association with clavicle fractures or operative exposure of the clavicle. Presenting symptoms of supraclavicular nerve injury may extend from altered sensibility, located only in the dermatome of the involved nerve branch, to diffuse hyperesthesia resembling a complex regional pain syndrome.<sup>2,3</sup>

Few reports exist regarding supraclavicular nerve injury, with recommendations for treatment ranging from nonoperative treatment featuring stellate ganglion blocks<sup>4</sup> to operative resection of the involved nerve.<sup>2,4</sup>

The purpose of this report is to note the successful outcome after neurolysis of a supraclavicular nerve compressed by fracture callus.
